

RE: CONSERVATION DISTRICT FORESTER

The Leelanau Conservation District is seeking a full-time forester. The position will include some of the following responsibilities:

- 1) Manage the District's spring and fall plant sales.
- 2) Manage the two native plant sales
- 3) Provide insect and disease diagnostic services
- 4) Do reconnaissance of smaller woodland acres and write management plans.
- 5) Provide referrals to consulting foresters.
- 6) Organize and Conduct educational programs and workshops for all age groups.
- 7) Provide plant identification services
- 8) Provide tree planting recommendations based on soils, exposures, landowners' desires.
- 9) Provide marking for TSI, Firewood Cuts, Small Harvests

The person hired will have an opportunity to develop and use some of his or her own program ideas. The intent is to grow the forestry program to better reach woodland owners in Leelanau County and to provide more environmental/natural resource education outreach. Fees for some services will be charged.
